Chromebook Dos, Don'ts and Need to Knows

Things to Do:

- You must bring your SDP issued chromebook and charger to school everyday.
- Chromebooks must be fully charged.
- Keep your password secret. Passwords should only be shared with parents or school staff.
- Chromebooks should be powerwashed when user encounter a major glitch (malfunction).
- Immediately report any problems, broken, damaged or lost to your teacher.

Chromebook Dos, Don'ts and Need to Knows

Things Not to Do:

- Do not carry your Chromebook by the screen or walk with the Chromebook while it is open. Make sure your Chromebook is properly stored in your school bag.
- Do not place decorations (such as stickers or drawings) on the Chromebook.
- Do not load movies, apps, games or any other software on the Chromebooks other than what is instructed by your teacher or staff.
- Do not attempt to gain access to other students or teachers accounts, files, or data.

Chromebook Dos, Don'ts and Need to Knows

Things Not to Do:

- Do not send unsolicited messages to other students.
- Do not throw your Chromebook.
- Do not sit books on top of your Chromebook.
- Do not charge your Chromebook on your bed or soft surface - sit at a desk or table when using your computer.
- Do not leave your Chromebook in an unsecure location unattended.
- Do not use Chromebooks for social media - “Power of Words”
- **NO GAMING!**

Chromebook Dos, Don'ts and Need to Knows

Things Not to Do:

- Do not give your Chromebook to another student for any reason.
- Do not physically alter your Chromebook in any way.
- Do not attempt any repairs to your Chromebook. All repairs are to be completed by SDP Staff Only.



Chromebook Dos, Don'ts and Need to Knows

Things to Know:

- Intentional damage will result in disciplinary action as well as charges for all repairs resulting from the damage that has occurred.
- Chromebooks will not be able to print. All assignments must be submitted digitally.
- Students have school email (12345678@philasd.org). No personal email accounts are allowed on SDP devices.
- Chromebooks are subject to inspection at any time without notice and remain the property of SDP.
